
# Arizona Career Ready Program Module Engaging All Students in Postsecondary Planning February 18 – March 18, 2019



## **COURSE OVERVIEW:**

This **online** course will cover how to successfully implement career and postsecondary plans (the ECAP process) at your site. Topics include the significance of educator involvement in career and postsecondary planning through ECAPs, how to engage students academically by understanding the relevance of current coursework with future career pathways and ideas for implementation and lesson planning.
